SINGAPURA: Dalam usaha untuk menyebarkan semangat Ramadan, NeuGen Fund, sebuah badan amal yang ditubuhkan Persatuan Syarikat Kerjasama Perusahaan dan Perkhidmatan (Iscos) yang menyokong kanak-kanak dan keluarga bekas pesalah,menganjurkan sebuah sesi berbuka puasa bersama.
