About NeuGen

When someone is incarcerated, the impact extends beyond the individual. Families and children often bear the brunt, facing the loss of a breadwinner, the sudden absence of a parental figure, strained relationships, and the social stigma associated with having an incarcerated loved one.

Children, in particular, are vulnerable to challenges such as financial instability, unpredictable parental behavior, fractured family dynamics, and struggles in their academic performance.

Research has shown that these children are not only more likely to experience lower educational attainment but also face an increased risk of engaging in criminal activities—a cycle known as intergenerational offending.

What is Intergenerational Offending?

Children with criminal parents are **3 times more likely** to become offenders.



1 in every 5 children of drug-abusing parents experience intergenerational offending

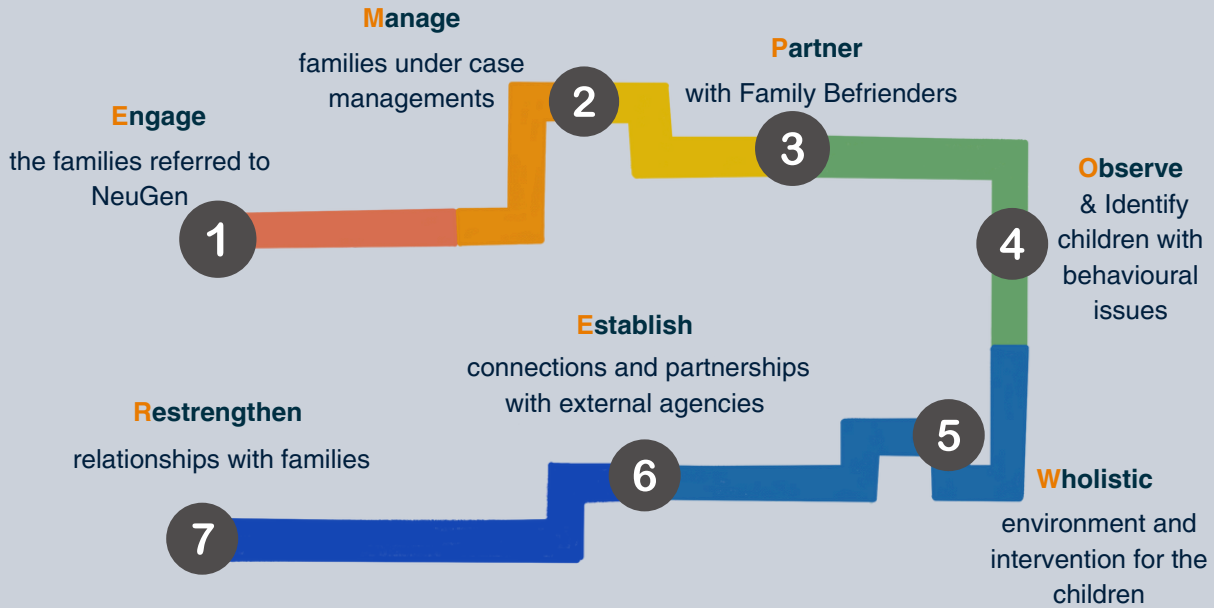

From joining Flair Football Academy at 6 to being selected for the U10 Junior National Development Centre in 2023, Amir has shown incredible talent. In 2024, he joined Lion City Sailors Academy, where he now receives sponsorship.

With NeuGen's support, through After School Activities, Amir balanced his love for football and academics, and is currently preparing to represent Lion City Sailors at the Gothia Cup in Sweden in July 2025.

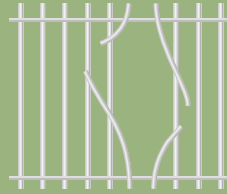
